A RESOLUTION REPEALING RESOLUTION 12-24 AND ADOPTING THE STATE PROCUREMENT CODE AND THE FEDERAL PROCUREMENT CODE

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Resolution is to adopt regulations to define the general and specific requirements of the Procurement Code; and

WHEREAS, the City is a home rule charter and as such has the opportunity to maintain its own Procurement Code or adopt the state procurement code and federal procurement code; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body may adopt regulations through resolution or ordinance to affect the powers and duties granted to municipalities by state law; and


WHEREAS, the Governing Body is adopting both the state procurement code and the federal procurement code; and

WHEREAS, the City will follow the more stringent of the codes in accordance with any state or federal laws.




