Entry Level: Per Pay Plan –


Nature of Job: Under direction to inspect construction work of contractors and city crews assigned to perform duties in the following functional areas: maintenance, repair, and construction of city streets, sidewalks, curbs, gutters, storm systems, and/or utilities; position is technical in nature and involves a variety of duties related to project inspection within city right-of-way. Inspects streets, sidewalks, barricades, signs, paint, and traffic control devices for maintenance repairs and safety hazards. Reviews operations, field developments, and productivity records. Determines where improvements can be made and recommends and implements changes. Responds to referrals of queries and complaints from the public. Determines materials and supplies needed to complete assigned projects. Inspects streets projects for compliance with specifications, standards and codes. Inspects materials and completed work for compliance with plans and specifications. Operates light and heavy motorized construction and maintenance equipment including graders, rollers, loaders, street sweepers, and backhoes, compressors, and pneumatic tools. Makes minor repairs to equipment, including replacement of routine maintenance parts, replacing storm drains and related fixtures. Qualifications: High School Diploma or GED and two years related experience and/or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience. Associate's Degree (A.A.) and seven years related experience and/or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience. Must possess a valid New Mexico Class D Operator's license and also must be insurable by the City's insurance carrier. Must possess Commercial Drivers License a class 'A' (CDL). A minimum of two (2) years of increasingly responsible experience in construction inspection, construction material testing and construction management with a minimum of one (1) year of experience in surveying of roads.


