**Resolution No. 20-72**



**WHEREAS**, the Mayor of the City of Las Vegas has extended the Proclamation of Civil Emergency Extending Curfew (“Proclamation”) until December 11, 2020 at 10:00 p.m.; and


WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City and the public health, safety and welfare of the City’s residents and visitors to work in cooperation with the Proclamation in the manner provided herein.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Las Vegas that the recitals are incorporated herein by reference and the Governing Body hereby prohibits any person, business or entity from selling or serving any beverage containing alcohol between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. during a period of time in which the Proclamation’s curfew is in effect.


