## This Week's Topic:

### EPA Brownfields Grant

The City is gearing up to submit a \$300,000 grant request to the Environmental Protection Agency, for an environmental assessment of the Gallinas River Walk Corridor.

This funding is to be used to identify areas that have been contaminated by historical industry, such as the railroad, plan contaminant remediation, and open doors to other funding areas. The project funded by this grant will help increase the ecological vigor of the Gallinas River and its riparian corridor, while increasing the health of this important community green space. The City hopes this grant will be one of many that will continue the redevelopment work of the Gallinas River Walk Park.
