This is ADDENDUM No. 1 to the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS FOR LAS VEGAS LANDFILL CORRECTIVE MEASURES AND CLOSURE PROJECT, bid package published November 2014.

This ADDENDUM No. 1 consists of two (2) page and six (6) items with two (2) attachments.

All interested bidders are hereby notified of the following modifications to the Contract Documents, as described in detail below:

Item 1. Revised Bid Opening Date and Time - Deadline for submitting Bids.

The bid opening date has been extended to Tuesday, December 9th, at 1:15 p.m. MST. The location of the bid opening remains unchanged.

Item 2. Deadline for submitting questions.

The deadline for submitting questions is extended to Monday, December 1, 2014 by 5:00 p.m. MST. All questions should be submitted in writing. Please email questions to the following email:

The final addenda addressing any questions will be issued on Wednesday, December 3rd, 2014.

Item 3. Revised Required Number of Bids.

The number of bids required to be submitted is revised to one (1) original and three (3) copies.

Item 4. Mandatory pre-bid meeting sign-in sheet resulting from the Pre-Bid meeting.

The mandatory pre-bid meeting sign-in sheet was created during the pre-bid meeting and is included as attachment to this addendum.

Item 5. Dewatering Incidental to Respective Bid Items.

Contractor is responsible for providing any dewatering required for completing the work. The cost of any dewatering shall be considered incidental to respective bid items and shall be included within their bid cost. No additional pay item is provided and no direct/separate payment will be provided for dewatering.

Item 6. Correction to Bid Form – Bid Item 25.

The Bid Form has been corrected and a revised version is included as an attachment to this addendum. A summary of the modification is listed below:

- Bid Item 25 (8-inch Gate Valve) – revised quantity is 2
Please note it has been confirmed the original quantities for Bid Items 23, 30 and 31 cover the 11 manholes shown in the drawings and remain unchanged.

This Addendum No. 1 constitutes clarification, changes, additions, modifications and/or deletions to the aforementioned contract documents. All provisions of the contract documents not in conflict with Addendum No. 1 shall remain in full force. Receipt of this Addendum shall be acknowledged on the Bid Form.

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ARTICLE 1 – BID RECIPIENT

1.02 The undersigned Bidder proposes and agrees, if this Bid is accepted, to enter into an Agreement with Owner in the form included in the Bidding Documents to perform all Work as specified or indicated in the Bidding Documents for the prices and within the times indicated in this Bid and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Bidding Documents.

ARTICLE 2 – BIDDER’S ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

2.01 Bidder accepts all of the terms and conditions of the Instructions to Bidders, including without limitation those dealing with the disposition of Bid security. This Bid will remain subject to acceptance for 60 days after the Bid opening, or for such longer period of time that Bidder may agree to in writing upon request of Owner.

ARTICLE 3 – BIDDER’S REPRESENTATIONS

3.01 In submitting this Bid, Bidder represents that:

- A. Bidder has examined and carefully studied the Bidding Documents, other related data identified in the Bidding Documents, and the following Addenda, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged:

- B. Bidder has visited the Site and become familiar with and is satisfied as to the general, local, and Site conditions that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.
- C. Bidder is familiar with and is satisfied as to all Laws and Regulations that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.
- D. Bidder has carefully studied all: (1) reports of explorations and tests of subsurface conditions at or contiguous to the Site and all drawings of physical conditions relating to existing surface or subsurface structures at the Site (except Underground Facilities) that have been identified in SC-4.02 as containing reliable "technical data," and (2) reports and drawings of Hazardous Environmental Conditions, if any, at the Site that have been identified in SC-4.06 as containing reliable "technical data."
- E. Bidder has considered the information known to Bidder; information commonly known to contractors doing business in the locality of the Site; information and observations obtained from visits to the Site; the Bidding Documents; and the Site-related reports and drawings identified in the Bidding Documents, with respect to the effect of such information, observations, and documents on (1) the cost, progress, and performance of the Work; (2) the means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction to be employed by Bidder, including applying the specific means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction expressly required by the Bidding Documents; and (3) Bidder’s safety precautions and programs.
- F. Based on the information and observations referred to in Paragraph 3.01.E above, Bidder does not consider that further examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies, or data are necessary for the determination of this Bid for performance of the Work at the price(s) bid and within the times required, and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Bidding Documents.
- G. Bidder is aware of the general nature of work to be performed by Owner and others at the Site that relates to the Work as indicated in the Bidding Documents.

- H. Bidder has given Engineer written notice of all conflicts, errors, ambiguities, or discrepancies that Bidder has discovered in the Bidding Documents, and the written resolution thereof by Engineer is acceptable to Bidder.
- 1. The Bidding Documents are generally sufficient to indicate and convey understanding of all terms and conditions for the performance of the Work for which this Bid is submitted.

ARTICLE 4 – BIDDER’S CERTIFICATION

4.01 Bidder certifies that:

- A. This Bid is genuine and not made in the interest of or on behalf of any undisclosed individual or entity and is not submitted in conformity with any collusive agreement or rules of any group, association, organization, or corporation;
- B. Bidder has not directly or indirectly induced or solicited any other Bidder to submit a false or sham Bid;
- C. Bidder has not solicited or induced any individual or entity to refrain from bidding; and
- D. Bidder has not engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, or coercive practices in competing for the Contract. For the purposes of this Paragraph 4.01.D:
 - 1. “corrupt practice” means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting of any thing of value likely to influence the action of a public official in the bidding process;
 - 2. “fraudulent practice” means an intentional misrepresentation of facts made (a) to influence the bidding process to the detriment of Owner, (b) to establish bid prices at artificial non-competitive levels, or (c) to deprive Owner of the benefits of free and open competition;
 - 3. “collusive practice” means a scheme or arrangement between two or more Bidders, with or without the knowledge of Owner, a purpose of which is to establish bid prices at artificial, non-competitive levels; and
 - 4. “coercive practice” means harming or threatening to harm, directly or indirectly, persons or their property to influence their participation in the bidding process or affect the execution of the Contract.
