Project Excellence

The City of Las Vegas Landfill-Corrective Measures and Closure Project, was awarded the 2016 ACEC Engineering Excellence award. The award was based on three factors:

- Complexity of the project, which involved capturing and treating pollutants
- Application of new and innovative technologies
- Long term sustainability of the project

The Landfill closure project was completed in late 2015 and it is now certain that our ground water and river are not being polluted by toxins coming from the landfill. This ensures an even safer water supply for the community. The City looks forward to working on other projects using new, innovative and sustainable techniques.
