Applications are being accepted for a full time **Airport Service Technician** for the City of Las Vegas Public Works Department.

Entry Level: Per Pay Plan – \$10.09

Nature of Job: This is a customer services oriented position involving the daily operation of the Las Vegas Municipal Airport. Work includes providing flight line services consisting of fueling aircraft. Employee will serve as liaison between the Municipal Airport and local businesses to assist in meeting customer needs in terms of food, lodging, communication, tourist, and business interests. Projects a professional physical appearance and mental attitude toward the City of Las Vegas Airport sales and services. Uses proper training to promote safe working conditions in a potentially hazardous work environment. Communicates clearly with aviation customers to provide the proper aircraft fuel, oil and airframe services in a safe and efficient manner. Obeys flight line rules for driving and positioning of fuel trucks, “chocking” airplane wheels, electrically grounding of aircraft prior to fueling, tying down aircraft during high wind conditions and for overnight storage. Maintains cleanliness of aircraft ramp, taxiways and runways to maintain a good appearance and minimize damage to aircraft tires and foreign object damage (FOD) to aircraft propellers and jet engines. Uses grass mowing and trimming equipment, snow sweepers/plows, weed spraying equipment to maintain airport grounds and paved areas. Inspects for proper condition, drives and operates aircraft fuel (piston and jet) truck delivery systems. Documents trucks mechanical condition noting deficiencies. Refills fuel trucks from bulk storage tanks, maintaining records of gallons transferred. (A detailed job description is available at the Human Resource Office.)

Qualifications: High School diploma or equivalent. Must possess a valid New Mexico Class D Operator’s license and also must be insurable by the City’s insurance carrier.
