
Nature of Job: The primary function of the employee is to perform technical municipal planning work involving the research, review, analysis and coordination of re-zoning, annexation, and general plan amendment related development requests, as well as architectural and site design analysis. Employee may also develop, update and distribute population statistics and demographic information, and assist with Census-related matters. This employee presents findings and recommendations to administration, staff, the planning and zoning commission, city council, and the public. The employee facilitates the development, implementation of the City's comprehensive master plan; downtown action plan, metropolitan redevelopment area plan and assessment districts. Takes the lead in the development and revisions of the five-year infrastructure capital improvement plans. Performs technical planning functions including research, review, analysis, presentation, and coordination of re-zoning, annexation, general plan amendment, development, use permit, variance, and related applications. Reviews development applications for compliance with the City's comprehensive master plan, development policies, and design codes. Performs site design analysis. 

Must have a minimum of two years professional planning experience or related government activities or equivalent in public administration experience.
