Nature of Job: This is a highly responsible professional position under the direct management of the City Manager. The director is responsible for the overall operation of the Community Services Department which includes Recreation, Senior Center, Library, Museum and Public Transportation Divisions. This position involves the oversight of the implementation of services, development and revision of policies, procedures, ordinances, financial budgeting and planning for all divisions including oversight and maintenance of the various associated facilities. The director shall be responsible for procurement of goods and services within the department. The director shall inform the City Manger of all Community Services operations and associated facilities business and shall report to Council or the public on issues as assigned by the City Manager.

Work is performed in accordance with accepted professional standards. Work requires application of a specialized body of experience. Work originates from the day-to-day functions of the City's Community Services, as well as from special needs of the Community and independent judgment in exercised in carrying out of duties. Work is reviewed through actual observation and review of reports. Work requires extensive public contact with City officials, other government representatives and general public.




