Applications are being accepted for a full time **Equipment Operator III** for the City of Las Vegas Streets Department.

**Entry Level:** Per Pay Plan – \$11.13

**Nature of Job:** The purpose of this position is to perform heavy manual work functions related to heavy equipment operation associated with road construction/maintenance drainage erosion, signage, etc., within the Public Works Department. Duties and responsibilities include operating/maintaining heavy equipment and providing heavy manual labor. Operates heavy equipment and machinery used in street and roadside construction and maintenance of small bulldozer, tractor, pup roller, back-hoe, single/double axle truck, mower, edger, chipper, chain saw and other equipment as required. Performs maintenance tasks necessary to keep equipment/machinery in good working condition such as obtaining fuel, maintaining fluid levels, obtaining parts, performing mechanical repairs, obtaining repairs from outside sources, performing preventive maintenance, etc. Provides heavy manual labor functions for landscaping and roadside projects including but not limited to cutting trees, spreading salt or gravel, patching roads, removing trash/litter, cleaning ditches/storm drains, sweeping, mopping, cleaning, etc. as directed. Performs labor-related duties involving bricklaying, pipe laying, sign installation, asphalt repair, right-of-way maintenance, etc.; assists in repairing storm drainage lines as instructed. Prepares and/or receives various forms, work orders, reports and other documents; completes, processes and forwards as appropriate. Responds to routine requests for information from officials, employees, members of the staff, the public or other individuals. 
