Entry Level: \$11.13

Nature of Job: Required to provide backup supervision if foreman is unavailable. This position requires considerable flexibility due to the different types of equipment used and assignment given. Operates light and/or heavy-duty specialized equipment in construction and maintenance, including wheeled or cledated tractors, power shovels, backhoe, front-end loader and similar heavy equipment. Shall act as lead worker over one or more semi-skilled or unskilled workers. Finished product or task is reviewed for adequacy by the department head or foreman. Guideline may be operator's and maintenance manuals and/or oral instructions. Digs channels, builds roads, shoulders, and performs other earthmoving. Operates transport trucks hauling heavy equipment. Operates a variety of heavy equipment. Performs maintenance, repairs and adjustments, both routine and emergency. Assists mechanics in performing major repairs by performing less technical details. Performs other work as required or assigned. Operates light heavy-duty specialized equipment in construction and maintenance, including wheeled or cledated tractors, power shovels, backhoe, front-end loader and similar heavy equipment. Operates various tools, light equipment, line locating equipment, all sizes of water tapping machines, hand tools, shovel, picks, valve wrenches, radio, tamper, dump truck, boom truck, service vehicles, jack hammer, rollers, cement mixer, saws, steel toed boots, vest, waders, gloves. Ability to operate equipment safely and efficiently. Ability to run grades and to operate heavy equipment in wet terrain without supervision. Ability to perform heavy manual work. Considerable knowledge of functions, operating methods and maintenance of a wide variety of heavy construction equipment. Knowledge of all phases of water distribution operations, and maintenance, including map and blue print reading (A detailed job description is available at the Human Resource Office.)


Qualifications: Valid New Mexico Class D drivers license, with good driving records. Must be insurable by City's insurance carrier. Must possess or obtain CDL license within 6 months of employment. Required to drive automobiles, pickups, dump trucks, backhoe, loader, service vehicles. Must have three(3) years experience in water maintenance, and five (5) years experience as heavy equipment operator. Must have practical experience in operating heavy duty construction equipment totaling five (5) years. Training may substitute for three (3) years of experience. Three (3) years of experience as Equipment Operator II may substitute for two (2) years experience as heavy equipment operator. Four (4) years experience installing pipe & fittings in water field. One (1) year practical experience in supervision of crews involved in maintaining and operating water work system.
