
Nature of Job: The Museum Specialist is a general position which assists with the maintenance and advancement of the City Museum and its collection as a source of information and research for the public. The Museum Specialist assists in the daily activities of the City Museum. Duties include maintaining the collection, which includes but is not limited to, handling, storage, cataloguing, and assessing items; monitoring storage and display environments. Other duties include performing historic research, assisting with the installation and de-installation of exhibits, assisting with programs for adults and children, assisting with the marketing of the City Museum's events, programs, and exhibits, and participation and assistance with the City Museum's Strategic Plan. Job performance is evaluated on the basis of direct observation of the Museum Services Administrator/Curator (MSA/Curator). Handles, photographs, catalogues, and assesses collection items. Provides support for research requests from the public, researchers, or students. Assists the MSA/Curator with the creation and physical installation and de-installation of exhibits within the Museum. Assists the MSA/Curator with the marketing of Museum events, exhibits, programs, and lectures. Assists the MSA/Curator with the planning and execution of the Strategic Planning Session. Assists the MSA/Curator with grant writing. Attends events or outreach programs as assigned. Welcomes visitors and performs front desk duties as assigned. Assists in maintenance of building and construction of platforms or exhibit material as needed. Assists in building custodial duties as assigned. Performs other related duties as assigned (A detailed job description is available at the Human Resource Office.)

Qualifications: Equivalent to a Bachelor's Degree or Associates Degree in Museum Studies, History or related field **plus** one year museum experience or the equivalent in historic institution or ANY combination of education, experience and training which provides the desired knowledge, skills and abilities. Experience with simple wood construction. Experience with building/grounds maintenance. Must possess a valid New Mexico Driver's License with an acceptable driving record and must be insurable by the City's Insurance carrier.
