

Organizes a variety of recreation programs that can include, drama, arts, crafts, music, and dance. May be required to assist in the maintenance, upkeep, renovation and repair of baseball fields, buildings, soccer fields, and playgrounds throughout the City as it pertains to recreation programs and special events. 
Qualifications: High School diploma or equivalent; Associates Degree (AA) from accredited two or four year institution preferred; or two or more years related experience, or equivalent combination of education and experience in recreation or related field. Ability to recognize and correct unsafe activities or unsportsmanlike conduct, to organize and control groups of children, to instruct in various sports and games. Knowledge of goals, practices and techniques of recreation as a leisure activity and learning experience for children. Some travel may be required, evening and weekend work may also be required in order to meet programming and special event deadlines.
