

ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATION NO. A-10-186

AN ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATION ESTABLISHING LIMITED ADDITIONAL DISPOSAL OF CERTAIN SOLID WASTE FOR RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS.

THIS ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATION REPEALS AND REPLACES IN ITS ENTIRETY ANY AND ALL PREVIOUS ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS REGARDING ANY AND ALL "LIMITED ADDITIONAL DISPOSAL OF CERTAIN SOLID WASTE FOR RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS" FOR THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS.

Until further notice by the City Manager, City Solid Waste Residential Customers may additionally dispose of their household waste at the City of Las Vegas Transfer Station Facility at no additional charge.

Previously, those who took their trash to the City Transfer Station were charged for their additional refuse. Now, under this Administrative Regulation, residential customers may take their additional residential waste directly to the Transfer Station without an additional fee.

The City of Las Vegas' environmental goal is to reduce community litter. Removing some of the citizen's cost of litter disposal will promote the following;

- Encourage citizens to take pride in their community through the proper disposal of waste; and
- Stop the illegal disposal of waste ; and
- Improper disposal of waste is not only unattractive, but it results in potential hazards such as soil, water and air contamination; and
- Remove some cost as a partial barrier to the proper disposal of waste.

Residential customers will not be charged under the following conditions:

- Residents are allowed additional disposal of waste created and brought from their utility billed location after producing a copy of a)their current utility bill and b)driver's license.
- Prior to departure to the Transfer Station, loads must be covered to prevent flying debris in route to the Transfer Station.
- All residential waste, except furniture, must be contained in individual bags that are tied shut.
- Yard waste, which includes grass and/or leaves, must be contained in tied up plastic trash bags.
- Limbs, branches and brush need not be bagged, but must be less than six (6) feet in length and not greater than six (6) inches in diameter.
- Residential waste must be delivered in a "personal vehicle" which includes but is not limited to automobile, station wagon, van, sport utility vehicle or any size personal pickup truck. Waste will not be

accepted when it appears to be transported in commercial vehicles or trailers being pulled by commercial vehicles.

- Household appliances may be accepted at the Transfer Station, except for refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners or appliances containing any type of refrigerant. The charge for these appliances will be:
 1. Resident must produce Certificate that refrigerant was removed: \$10.00
 2. Resident who fails to produce Certificate that refrigerant was removed: \$40.00
 3. This Rule does not apply to "Special Waste" which will be charged as a per tire minimum fee of \$5.00 plus tax
Special Waste includes but is not limited to:
 - Passenger Tires: 15" and under \$5.00 per tire
 - Truck Tires: 16" and over \$10.00 per tire
 - Tractor and Semi-truck Tires: \$20.00 per tire

Ineligible Waste Disposal

The following waste types are **not** eligible for free disposal at the City of Las Vegas Transfer Station.


1. Commercial waste as per 20NMAC 9.1 regulation.
2. Commercial construction, demolition or remodeling waste materials, examples include but are not limited to roof shingles, dirt, concrete, asphalt, lumber (2 X 4's, molding, door framing), paneling, vinyl, insulation, windows, doors, carpet, and padding, as well as auto parts, machinery, and engine blocks.
3. Mixed waste loads that contain materials that are acceptable and unacceptable for free disposal are subject to appropriate charges.
4. Waste delivered in commercial vehicles, rental trucks, vehicles with commercial tags, or vehicles licensed outside of City of Las Vegas service area, or any vehicle deemed commercial by City of Las Vegas staff.
5. Dense items – items that are larger than 2 feet by 2 feet by 2 feet and weigh more than 200 lbs.
6. The following waste types are not accepted at the City of Las Vegas Transfer Station in accordance to the State of New Mexico Environment Solid Waste Management Regulations 20NMAC 9.1.
 - Section 001 Bulk liquid waste.
 - Section 001 Dirt
 - Section 001 Concrete
 - Section 005 Asbestos Tree root balls
 - Section 006 Infectious waste
 - Section 007 Ash
 - Section 008 Petroleum products
 - Section 009 Sludge
 - Section 010 Animal Carcass or parts
 - Section 011 Bulk liquid waste

If there is a disagreement as to what will be charged, the Solid Waste employee will have the final decision before calling the Utility Director.

Trash may be disposed of during normal working hours at the Transfer Station which are Monday through Friday, 7:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. and Saturdays 9:00 a.m.– 12:45 p.m. For more detailed information call 505-426-0351 or visit our Web Site at www.lasvegasnm.gov

This Administrative Regulation shall become effective immediately upon approval by the City Manager.
