

**MONTHLY REPORT FOR
ABE MONTOYA RECREATION CENTER
July 2010**

1. May 16th, the Recreation Center started closing on Sundays during the summer months. Parties are being accommodated on Saturdays.
2. Working on plans for front lobby – Working with Public Works dept and recreation maintenance staff to implement a plan to install a turnstile with controlled access to accommodate a more organized flow of traffic into the recreation facility.
3. Summer Seasonal hires – The Recreation Center currently has 33 full and part-time summer staff. Staff is being utilized as life guards, control clerk, maintenance, and summer recreation camp. 3 summer seasonals and 2 rec staff were certified as lifeguards on June 28th.
4. New recreation programs –
 - a. RFP's to take to council for additional services to recreation center such as personal training, karate, self defense and senior fitness programs.
5. Summer Camp – Currently, there are 136 enrolled in summer camp. This year accommodations were made for half – day and full day status. Recreation camp field trips include the museum, library, parks, Luna Community college, and 21st Century school at Armijo.
6. Adult Softball League – On Friday, the mid-season annual All – Star game will be played. Women start at 6:15pm and the men will start at 8:00pm at the Rodriguez softball field.
7. Special Events
 - a. TEEN WEEK – July 19th to the 23rd Monday through Friday from 6pm to 9pm. For \$3.00, the recreation staff will provide presentations and recreation activities for teen's grades 7th through 9th grade. For a list of events, pick up a flyer from the Recreation Center.
8. Senior Olympics – State Senior Olympics begins on Monday July 26 through August 1 in Las Cruces. Over 25 local seniors will participate in a variety of events such as horseshoes, 8-ball pool, badminton, swimming, track, golf, shuffleboard, archery, pistol, bowling, and volleyball, just to name a few.
