

**MONTHLY REPORT FOR
ABE MONTOYA RECREATION CENTER
JULY 2011**

1. **MAINTENANCE REPAIRS** – The Recreation Center has been experiencing fluctuation with the air conditioning units in the Phase I and Phase II areas. Several issues were addressed and the maintenance staff continues to correct, replace and improve the quality of air in the recreation center. Thank all for their patience during times of high temperatures that directly affects the temperatures in the recreation center.
2. **WATER CONSERVATION** – in order to reduce the water consumption in the recreation center, we urge all patrons to conserve water by taking quick showers. Help us all conserve water in the recreation center.
3. **RECREATION PROGRAMS** –
 - **SWIM LESSONS** – Sessions will run through the summer and classes will meet on Tuesdays and Thursdays 8am and 9am - six (6) classes per session at \$30.00 a session per child/adult. Sign up early, class sessions fill up quickly, 10 participants per class session.
 - **PARENT/CHILD GOLF CAMP** – Has 6 sets of parents/children in the golf camp. There are 4 sessions in this camp. Camp is running from July 6 to July 27th.
 - **New! LAND ZUMBA AND ZUMBATRONICS** for children! Beginning Saturday July 23rd, the recreation department will offer a land aerobics for adults as well as a kids Zumba aerobics dance called Zumbatronics. This is a great fun way for kids to exercise! All classes are \$3.00 a class or purchase a CLASS PASS for \$24.00 which gives you 10 classes for the price of 8. Call Misty at recreation center for more information on these two (2) new classes.
 - **COED SOFTBALL TOURNAMENT** – August 6th and 7th. Entry fee is \$150.00. Registration forms can be picked up at recreation department. Recreation staff is going to host a fun coed softball tourney set at the Rodriguez softball fields.
 - **BACK TO SCHOOL PARTY NIGHT and SKATEBOARD CONTESTS** - Back to school party night and skateboard contests are being planned for August by the recreation staff. More information will be announced as soon as possible.
 - **CATCH THE KID** special event - Recreation Department is assisting with “Catch the kid” event to be held on July 23, 2011.
 - **SENIOR OLYMPICS**- State Senior Olympics will be held in Las Cruces July 23, 2011 to July 31, 2011. There are 75 Las Vegas senior Olympians that participated in the local games, and approximately 25 to 30 that placed 1st thru 6th place will be traveling to Las Cruces for the state games.  - **SUMMER DAY CAMP PROGRAM** - This week, campers are participating in theme week which include themes such as Harry Potter, Sponge Bob, Scooby Doo, and Toy Story. Last week the campers visited the local banks and post office for field trips. Day campers are also participating in learn to golf sessions at the NMHU golf course.
