



RELEASE AND SHORT TERM RESOLUTION
OF EXECUTIVE ORDER 2010-04
SUSPENSION OF SEPTAGE DUMPING AT THE
CITY OF LAS VEGAS WASTE WATER FACILITY

WHEREAS, On May 12, 2010, Mayor Alfonso E. Ortiz, Jr. issued Executive Order 2010-04 suspending receiving septage at the City of Las Vegas Wastewater Treatment Facility to protect the integrity of the Waste Water/Pretreatment Ordinance No. 07-26A and NPDES Permit No. NM0028827; and

WHEREAS, The City took emergency steps including consulting with professional consulting engineers and operators from private and public firms to evaluate the treatment process and take steps to improve the conditions that existed at the treatment facility; and

WHEREAS, The treatment process has improved to the point where the treatment facility can begin accepting septage on a limited basis; and

WHEREAS, City staff are directed to continue looking into long term solutions to improve septage and solids handling to protect the treatment process from future upsets; and

WHEREAS, City staff are authorized to set restrictions limiting the volume of septage received; and

WHEREAS, City staff will give priority to current City water customers and only allow septage from other areas as long as treatment conditions and permit limits allow for receipt of septage; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that I, Alfonso E. Ortiz, Jr., at this time, hereby release Executive Order 2010-04 effective 2nd of August, 2010.
