



OVH

PA, IVC and induction with propofol. Intubated and maintained on isoflurane gas and oxygen mix. Patient placed in dorsal recumbency and was instrumented with anesthetic monitoring devices. A ventral abdominal midline clipping & surgical prep was performed. A local line block was administered then the patient was moved to surgical suite, placed in dorsal recumbency and secured on circulating heated water blanket covered with towel. The patient was prepped aseptically with chlorhexidine scrub and alcohol and then a surgical drape was placed.

Normal bronchovesicular sounds - Bilaterally

Cutting cautery was used to make an incision through the skin then a #10 blade was used for sharp dissection through fat and subcutaneous tissues to approach level of the linea. Using thumb forceps to tent the linea, the #10 blade scalpel was inserted into the linea to create an opening. A guided push cut technique was used to extend the linea incision cranially and caudally. The urinary bladder was distended and a cystocentesis was performed using a #22 gauge needle to allow for appropriate visualization of the remaining abdominal contents. The left ovary was exposed. A clamp was placed on the proper ligament of the ovary. Three clamps were placed on the suspensory ligament. The lowest clamp was released and a transfixing suture of 2-0 Monocryl was double ligated. The suspensory ligament was transected between the remaining two clamps. The clamps were released & the stump was visually inspected for bleeding. When satisfied there was no bleeding, the stump was replaced in the abdomen. This process was repeated for the right ovary. Then 2 transfixing sutures of 2-0 Monocryl were placed around uterine pedicle just below the bifurcation & double ligated. The pedicle was cut between two clamps. The clamps were released & the pedicle was observed for bleeding. The linea alba was sutured with 2-0 Monocryl in a simple continuous pattern. The subcutaneous layer was closed with a simple continuous pattern using 2-0 Monocryl. The subcuticular layer was closed with 2-0 Monocryl. One drop of skin glue was placed to close any defects in the incision. Isoflurane turned off then Dexdomitor reversed with Antisedan while oxygen continued to flow. Patient maintained on oxygen until awake and swallowing, then patient extubated. Patient recovered uneventfully from anesthesia. Administered microchip SQ on dorsum between scapula. Gave Carprofen Inj. SQ.
