ENTERPRISE EXPENSE



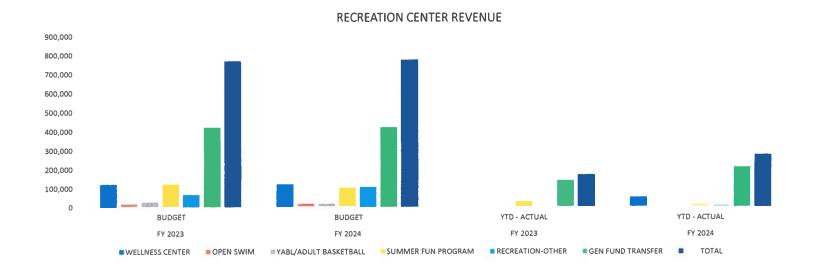

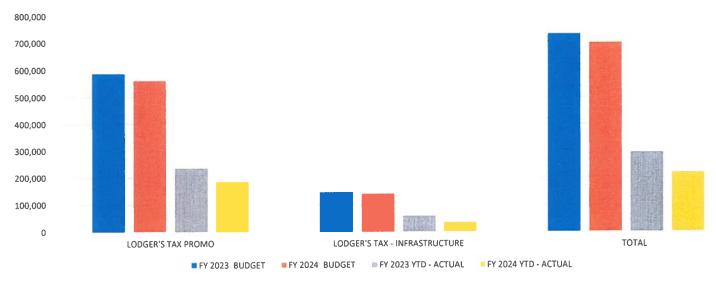

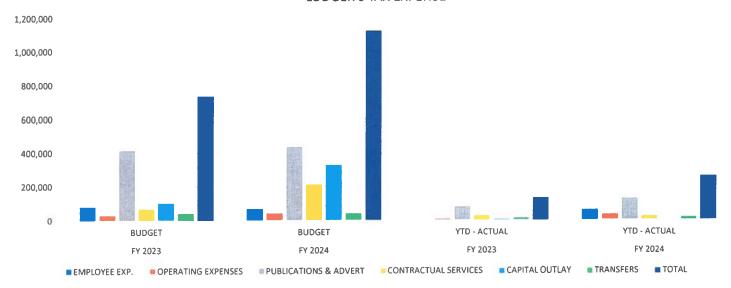




LODGER'S TAX REVENUE

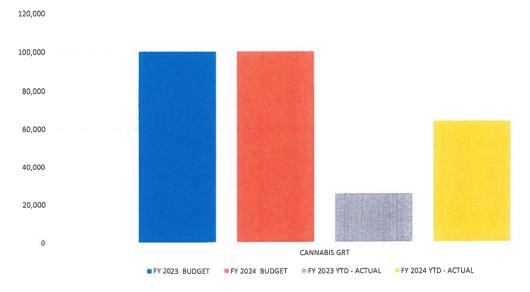

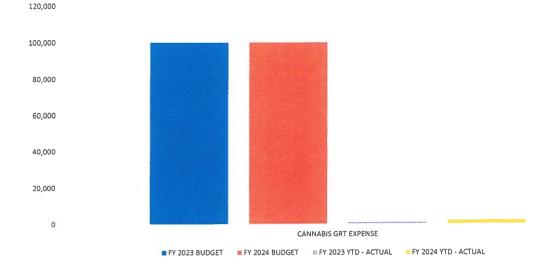

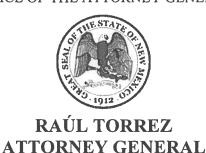
