*Hot Springs waterline project: The contractor has installed a pipe casing across the Mills intersection. They are currently preparing to asphalt patch the trench. During this time there will be altering closures for the East or West bound traffic at the Mills Avenue intersection.*

*New Mexico & Rio Arriba to Valencia Waterline Replacement contractor has completed all water service lines & tie-ins. Pavement Patching is scheduled to be completed by May 31, 2024.*
