Councilor Martinez asked if Ms. Mathews' intent was to sell packaged liquor and allow it to be taken off the premises.

Ms. Mathews advised the liquor license was for both dispensary and packaged, however there were requirements that had to be met and was unsure if it could be near a school zone, she just intended to open a full bar at that time.


Councilor Casey made a motion to adjourn. Councilor Ulibarri seconded the motion.
